The Kennel Club has asked that we draw attention to the potential health & safety implications concerning the use of soft crates as in its view, they do not offer sufficient protection to dogs. They have asked that we point out that dogs should not be left unattended in soft crates. There have been instances where dogs have escaped from soft crates which have not been securely fastened to benches, or that have been left at ringside. We therefore ask that if you use soft crates, you do not leave the dogs unattended, either in the hall, or in an open car in the car park.

## **JUDGES PROFILES**

### **MR MARTYN J REES - *Tyndale***

I should firstly like to take this opportunity of thanking the Officers & Committee for their generous invitation to judge at this show. I am greatly looking forward to the day & having the chance to assess your dogs. I started showing over 30 years ago – firstly in Rottweilers. My interest in Gundogs really started in the early 1990's when my parents purchased a Flatcoated Retriever whom I showed to his full title. I have always been passionate about the working side of Gundogs & my subsequent Flatcoats also obtained their Show Gundog Working Certificate as well as their Stud Book numbers. Currently I own a working bred Golden Retriever who is my second from a very successful working line & with whom I hope to compete at Field Trials in the future. I started judging towards the end of the 1990's & now award CC's in Flatcoated Retrievers. In the last few years I have commenced judging other Gundog breeds at Open Show level, which I derive great pleasure from. Although I no longer exhibit I attend a great many Championship shows as a spectator, which gives me the chance to watch as many breeds as possible. I particularly enjoy furthering my education by attending seminars & learning from the breed experts. The lesser known Gundog breeds are of great interest to me & I am relishing the opportunity of judging them at this show.

### **MISS BECKY JOHNSON - *Downstream***

I am very honoured to be judging Golden Retrievers, Cocker Spaniels & all the Setter breeds for Cornwall Gundog Club & thank the Committee for this invitation. In over 20 years judging, I have never judged in Cornwall. I am very fortunate to be a second generation dog person in that my parents founded the Downstream Flatcoats before producing me! I therefore grew up with their love of the breed. Our kennel has produced several dual purpose title holders since its formation. The most famous being Ch Downstream Destiny's Child JW – winner of 22 CC's & 20 RCC's & several group placings. Not just a pretty face she worked alongside the rest of our team throughout the shooting season. I first awarded CC's in Flatcoats in 2002 & am now passed for a further 12 breeds & the Gundog Group. I have also started to judge Terriers at open show level. I was formally Show Secretary for the United Retriever Club – a post which I held & enjoyed hugely for 13 years. I serve on the General Committee of Richmond Ch Dog Show & the Flatcoated Retriever Society & in the past have also held the position of Field Trial Secretary. I wrote the extended Breed Standard for the Flatcoated Retriever Society & help other breed clubs with their seminars & training days. I also write the Flatcoat breed notes for Dog World.

### **MRS SALLY PARR - *Kymin***

I have always shown my dogs, Cavaliers since the 60's as a child – Labradors since mid 80's & Tollers when I purchased a bitch a few years after their quarantine into UK. I started judging in the mid 90's, in both UK & Europe & helped run Field Trials when younger. I have competed at Gundog working tests with my Labs. When ill health stopped me picking up alongside all the retriever breeds, on the local steep Welsh hills I switched to truffle hunting, as I like a dog to have a purpose/job.

## DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club. Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must be at the time of entry a member of the Society. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. **26<sup>th</sup> July, 2019**. Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value. A dog is not eligible for entry in Variety classes unless also entered and subsequently exhibited in a breed class where such a class is provided for which it is eligible. Exemptions from this regulation are:-

- 1: A puppy, unless a class for dogs under twelve months of age for which it is eligible is provided for the breed.
- 2: A dog in Any Variety Field Trial or Working Trial class.
- 3: A dog in Any Variety Veteran class.
- 5: As provided in Kennel Club definitions of classes.
- 6: A dog which is withdrawn from exhibition in breed classes as a result of the appointment of an emergency Judge.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

- 1: Withdrawal – The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) and 20.
- 2: Transfer:
  - a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height or, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
  - b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or twenty-four calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior Or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
  - c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
  - d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

**MINOR PUPPY** – For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the show.

**PUPPY** – For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the show.

**JUNIOR** – For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the show.

**YEARLING** – For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the first day of the show.

**NOVICE** – For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more first prizes at Open or Championship shows – Minor Puppy, Puppy & Special Puppy class excepted whether restricted or not.

**GRADUATE** – For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**POST GRADUATE** - For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**LIMIT** – For dogs which have not become Show Champions under the Kennel Club regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won seven or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit and Open classes confined to the breed, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**OPEN** – For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the show.

**VETERAN** – For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the show.

**SPECIAL VETERAN** – For dogs of 7 to 9 years of age on the first day of the show – Classes 1 & 2

**SPECIAL VETERAN** – For dogs of not less than ten years of age on the first day of the show – Class 3

**BRACE OR TEAM** – For two or more exhibits (either sex or mixed) of one breed belonging to the same exhibitor, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

**JUNIOR HANDLING** – A class judged on handling ability, restriction of entry by age of handler, dogs handled in this class to be entered in breed or AVNSC class at this show.

**SPECIAL CHAMPION** – For dogs which have been confirmed a Champion, Show Champion or Field Trial Champion – dogs must compete in breed or AVNSC classes to be eligible for Best in Show.

**SHOW CERTIFICATE OF MERIT** – For dogs which have been confirmed a Show Certificate of Merit winner – dogs must compete in breed or AVNSC classes to be eligible for Best in Show.

**GOOD CITIZEN SCHEME** – For dogs that have achieved their GCDS Bronze award or above.

**SPECIAL WORKING GUNDOG** – For dogs which have won prizes and awards in recognised competition at Gundog Working Test or have gained their Show Gundog Qualifier or a Gundog Working Certificate

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The show will open at 8.30.
2. Dogs will be received at any time but it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
3. Judging will commence at 9.30.
4. The show will be unbenched. Exhibits may be removed from the show after their judging has been completed. The show will close half an hour after judging has been completed by which time dogs must be removed.
5. The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of the tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.
6. Entry fees: Members - £3.50 - Non-Members - £4.50 per dog - Stakes Class - £3 – Handling classes 50p.  
Membership: Single £3.00 - Joint £4.00 – Junior £1.00 – Due 1<sup>st</sup> January annually.  
Catalogues - £3 prepaid with entries - £3.50 on the day if available. Advertisements - £5 full page & £3 half a page.
7. Prize money: Shirley Crisp Memorial Stakes Class 76 only, is: 1<sup>st</sup> £20 – 2<sup>nd</sup> £15 – 3<sup>rd</sup> 10 – 4<sup>th</sup> - £5  
BIS - £15 RBIS - £10 3<sup>RD</sup> BIS - £5 4<sup>TH</sup> BIS £3 BPIS - £10 – BVIS £10  
Amount of entry & other fees, and if applicable details of how entries can be made via the internet.
8. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
9. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
10. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.

### 11. Best Puppy in Show

Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same show. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best in Show is a puppy it should automatically be awarded Best Puppy in Show respectively. Where the Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it should also automatically be Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best in Show respectively.

### 12. Best in Show

Best in Show must be selected from the exhibits declared Best of Sex but only if they have received a first prize in a class at the same show. If a Reserve Best in Show is to be selected, the eligible dogs are those declared Best Opposite Sex and the Reserve Best of Sex to the exhibit declared Best in Show.

13. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.

14. Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.

15. All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.

16. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.

### 17. DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.

**18. Not for Competition:**

Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered or

**19.** No modifications will be made to the schedule except by permission of the Board of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine press wherever possible.

**20:** Exhibit numbers must be displayed on all cages and crates.

**21:** Except when securely benched or caged Dogs must be on a lead for the duration of the show including the exercise area, especially as this is a farm and there are sheep horses and cattle on the premises.

**22:** Exhibitors who bring children to the venue will be held totally responsible for any damage the Children do whilst at the show.

**23.** Any exhibitor whose cheque is not honoured by the Bank will also incur any additional charges the Bank may pass onto the Cornwall Gundog Club. Failure to pay these charges in full will be reported to the Kennel Club.

<b>REGULATION FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F (B)</b>
--

**1)** These regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these show regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Limited rule A 11.

a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.

b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these regulations, then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A 11.

**2) a)** No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show.

b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.

**3)** No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:

a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.

b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed.

c) Operations to prevent breeding providing that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.

Nor must anything be done calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.

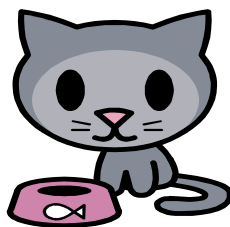
**4)** The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dogs or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club Limited in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.

**5)** An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official ( as Appropriate) to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club Limited will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.

**6)** Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.
